Paint



See how this painting was created using minerals and glue made from yak skin.

Clay



This sculpture is sculpted from clay over a wooden frame, or armature.

Silk



The image of this deity was created by making tiny knots out of silk threads.

Metal



Many of the sculptures in the museum are made from metals such as gold, silver, bronze, and copper.

Gems



Green Tara wears a crown and jewelry adorned with semi-precious stones.

The sculpture of this deity is from Nepal, which is known for woodcarvings.
